

## EuroDisney 2018 - Hotel Room Consent

Dear Parents/Guardians

Accommodation during the trip is at the B & B Hotel with the girls staying in rooms of 3.

The hotel is close to EuroDisney and we have asked for all rooms to be close together. Adults will be in rooms as close as possible to their age group. All girls will be told which rooms the adults are staying in should they need to speak to an adult during the evening or night.

The planned arrangements are as follows;

- U14 – allocated in rooms of 3.
- U15 – allocated in rooms of 3.
- Adults – allocated to adult only rooms of 2 or 3

In the event that the room arrangements are different to the above, I acknowledge that the decision of the Tour Committee on site will be guided by the best interests of safeguarding all the girls and accept their decision.

## EuroDisney 2018 - Mobile Phone Consent

Dear Parents

As a safety precaution, parents have requested their daughters take their mobile phone with them on the trip. While we aware there are advantages to this, there are also some disadvantages that we need to recognise and have come up with the following procedures

- While the club gives permission for mobile phones to be taken on tour, responsibility for the mobile phone rests with each girl. The club will bear no financial responsibility for loss, damage or theft however caused. The club strongly recommends insurance is taken out on your daughter's phone to cover its use whilst on tour.
- All mobiles will be used in a sensible way for normal usage. Any inappropriate use of mobile phones whilst on the trip will result in the immediate confiscation of the mobile phone.
- Girls are not permitted to take, store and/or transmit photographs/videos of each other which may be deemed offensive, inappropriate, abusive, violent, criminal and/or discriminatory
- Girls must ensure that files stored on their mobile phones do not contain violent, degrading or inappropriate images.
- Girls are responsible for their phones at all times. Phones should not be left unattended at any time.
- No images should be taken and circulated via social media that in anyway could harm, embarrass or upset the subject of the photo.
- Data-roaming and downloads are the responsibility of girls/parents and not the club or adults travelling on the trip
- Phones should not be used at all during tournament and coaching times
- Should phones be confiscated, they will be returned to their parent/guardian on return home, or passed to the police if appropriate.

## EuroDisney 2018 - Medication Consent

Dear Parents

We wish to reiterate good practice that girls should not take their own medication to EuroDisney with them. Any prescription medicine should be clearly labelled with full details of your daughter's name and dosage and handed your daughter's age group representative as we board the coach. Where relevant, EpiPens/inhalers should be carried by each girl with a spare EpiPen/inhaler delivered to their age group coordinator prior to departure.

We will take the following medicines with us and seek your consent to give such medicine to your daughter should the need arise. Can you please indicate (tick in the right hand box) which medication we may give to your daughter if necessary?

## **EuroDisney 2018 - Code of Conduct**

Outlined below is a code of conduct that parents should read and discuss with their daughters. We would appreciate you signing the declaration to agree this code will be upheld to ensure a safe and enjoyable tour.

Each girl on tour is expected to:

- Inform tour leaders immediately if they have any worries or problems.
- Observe normal club rules on/off the court.
- Co-operate with tour leaders at all times
- Fulfil any tasks or duties set prior to and during the visit.
- Participate fully in all activities during the visit – this does not include any water sports.
- Be punctual at all times.
- Not leave group sessions or accommodation without permission.
- Always return to the meeting point or accommodation at agreed times.
- If granted indirectly supervised time, stay in groups of no less than 3 young people.
- Avoid behaviour which might inconvenience others.
- Be considerate to others at all times.
- Respect all requests and requirements made by tour leaders and accompanying adults.
- Behave at all times in a manner which reflects credit on self, to the party and to the club.
- Abide by laws, rules and regulations of France and places visited.
- Not purchase or consume alcohol, drug or tobacco products.
- If in doubt on any matter, consult with tour leaders.
- Accept that a full written report will be forwarded to parents as a consequence of not upholding this code.
- Each girl is responsible for their own belongings, phones, cameras etc.
